# 2022 MOA RULES

## General Membership Information

1. PLATINUM Single Membership - \$325
2. PLATINUM Family Membership - \$550
  - a. Includes 2 Adult Passes (Must be family)
3. PLATINUM Corporate Membership - \$1,000
  - a. Include 4 Adult Passes (Must be valid business)
4. PLATINUM “Dog Tag” Membership - \$275
  - a. Veterans must provide their DD-214 to be applicable for this military discounted pricing.
5. Fundraising is Mandatory – Volunteering, Meeting and Event Attendance is NOT REQUIRED, but FUNDRAISING IS REQUIRED as part of your MOA Membership. You are required to sell a minimum of \$200 worth of fundraising tickets or you have the choice to opt out of fundraising. To opt out of fundraising entirely, you can simply add \$200 per annual membership pass. This \$200 opt-out fee must be paid up front with the purchase of your MOA 2022 Membership.

# 2022 MOA RULES

## a. Example

- i. Single:  $\$325 + \$200 = \$525$
- ii. Family:  $\$550$  (2 passes) +  $\$400 = \$950$
- iii. Corporate: (4 passes)  $\$1,000 + \$800 = \$1,800$

12. **Trapping** – Trapping is permitted by getting written permission from the MOA. (Limited Availability)
13. **Handicap Golf Cart**– Those with a physical handicap or impairing health condition can apply for pass to be used at access B-1 and B-2 only. Proof of insurance must be provided and passes can be purchased at the MOA Bait and Tackle Shop.

## Fishing

1. **“Daniels Run”** - OPEN Year Round
  - (a) GPS - Latitude: 40.030572 Longitude: -80.092213
  - (b) Address: 1881 Lone Pine Road, Marianna PA 15345
  - (c) Bait – Fly Fishing and Artificial Tackle Only
  
2. **“Ten Mile Creek - A”**– OPEN January 1 – August 31
  - (a) GPS - Latitude: 40.011137 Longitude: -80.063552
  - (a) 17 Davis Lane, Marianna PA 15345
  - (a) Bait – Artificial and Live Bait
  
3. **“Ten Mile Creek – B-1 and B-2”** –OPEN Year Round
  - (a) Latitude: 39.997709 Longitude: -80.040511
  - (b) B-1 “Upstream of Dam”
    - (i) Fly Fishing and Artificial Tackle Only
  - (c) B-2 “Downstream of Dam”
    - (i) Bait – Artificial and Live Bait

- 1) Strictly Prohibited - No forms of Dough Bait, including Powerbait or similar products. No forms of chumming, trout feed, chow or use of corn. If caught, immediate Membership suspension will be enforced.
- 2) September 1 – April 30
  - a) Catch and Release ONLY – ALL Members (Strictly Enforced)
- 3) May 1 – August 31
  - a) Fishing Areas of Ten Mile Creek Access A, B-1 and B-2
    - i) Platinum Members can keep 2 trout per week.
  - b) Daniels Run (Ed Thomas Memorial Fish Park)
    - i) Catch and Release Only Year-Round – (Strictly Enforced)
- 4) Nets
  - a) Members MUST carry and use a Net to land all fish.
- 5) Single Hooks
  - a) Barbs are Required to be Pinched or Barbless
- 6) Forceps / Hemostats / Pliers
  - a) Hooks are to be removed with hemostats, forceps, pliers or tools of equal comparison.

- 7) Plugs and Spinners
  - a) Barbs are Required to be Pinched or Barbless
- 8) Handling of Fish
  - a) When landing a fish, the fish is not to leave the water unless for a brief photo.
  - b) Fish should never be on the ground, in the mud or flopping out of the water.
  - c) If you keep a fish out of the water for excessive periods of time, the MOA has the right to discipline as deemed necessary.
  - d) You are to wet your hands before ever touching a fish.
  - e) If your hook is not immediately in the perimeter of a fishes mouth, you are to cut your line.
- 9) PA State Fishing License and Trout Stamp are required
- 10) All MOA Members must wear an MOA Member Button and have a MOA Parking Pass displayed on the front mirror of your vehicle while parked on MOA property, including guest pass(es).
- 11) MOA Member Button must be displayed at all times or will be asked to leave the property. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 12) Two fishing rods max per angler (June 1 through August 31, Ten Mile Creek Only).
- 13) NO Glass bottles and NO foam coolers
- 14) NO electrofishing, netting, spearing, snagging or bowfishing
- 15) NO Littering! All trash is to be placed in trash receptacles or taken with you.
- 16) NO cleaning or gutting of fish in waterway. If you clean fish at a camp site, you must take entrails with you.
- 17) Pets must be on a leash at all times. You must pick up after your pet.
- 18) NO open fires, except in designated and marked areas
- 19) NO taking fish off of the stringer to replace for another fish
- 20) NO treble hooks (2 or 3 hooks) permitted unless on a spoon, spinner or plug
- 21) NO minnow seines permitted on any MOA Property
- 22) Only small minnow traps with a 2 inch round hole is permitted
- 23) NO chumming, use of corn or imitation corn
- 24) NO use of chemicals, oils or attractants for fishing are not permitted to be used in any waterway.  
(example: WD-40)
- 25) NO loud music.
- 26) NO Golf Carts, ATV's or UTV's permitted on the property without written permission
- 27) Any photos taken on the M.O.A property or at any M.O.A events, or videos produced are the sole ownership of the M.O.A. and may be used on social media, website, advertisement and at the discretion of the M.O.A. Any person or business soliciting from their outdoor experience must properly cite and give credit to the Marianna Outdoorsmen Association.
- 28) NO mishandling of fish or wildlife. If the Fish Committee feels you are not properly releasing fish and you have fish floating around you, you will pay for the fish and asked to leave. If it continues to happen, you will lose your membership.
- 29) You must have your own stringer (June 1 – August 31, Ten Mile Creek Only). Once your limit of 2 fish is on your stringer, you are done for the day. If this completes your full limit of the week, you are done until 12:01 a.m. of the following Sunday. Fish must stay in the location of where they are caught.

- 30) NO stringers or gallon buckets permitted in any Catch and Release Area or out of designated harvesting periods.
- 31) Fish that are being kept must stay in the water until you leave, on a stringer or fish bag. No keeping fish in coolers. Once fish are in your vehicle, you are done fishing for the day.
- 32) Fish Kill -If you accidentally kill a fish out of season or in a Catch and Release area, you will pay a minimum fee of \$1 per inch, per fish taken to compensate MOA for the cost of the fish.
  - a) Example: 25 inch fish = \$25
  - b) Pay fee at drop box at MOA Bait Shop or at the MOA Fish Park. Note on payment envelope your MOA Membership Number, contact information, date and time.
  - c) If you kill a fish without an adequate membership, out of season, out of designated areas, against the rules or break laws, or simply knowingly allow a fish to float dead and choose to not remove the fish from the water and do not pay the \$1 fee, the MOA will assess a penalty of \$50 per fish killed.
- 33) Guiding or Outfitting - is strictly prohibited without written consent from the MOA.
- 34) Destruction of property means expulsion from club.
- 35) MOA reserves the right to close sections of stream for special events, safety and construction.

# 2022 MOA RULES

## 5 - Stand Range

1. You must be a Platinum Member.
2. MEMBERSHIP PIN MUST BE DISPLAYED WHILE AT THE RANGE
3. Any shooter under 18 must be accompanied by an adult member 18 or older
4. Club not responsible for accidents
5. Shoot at your own risk
6. Eye and hearing protection are required
7. Claybirds only
8. KEEP RANGE CLEAN; PLACE spent hulls IN TRASH CAN or take them with you.
9. 1 Hour limit
10. SHOOTING TIME-8:AM TO 4:PM
11. Shooting in designated areas only
12. When persons are down range, gun actions must be open
13. All gun's slow fire only
14. No fully automatic guns (Single shot, double barrel, Semi shotguns only) No AR/AK style shotguns
15. No alcoholic beverages allowed
16. Service dogs only permitted at gun range; no pets allowed
17. Destruction of property means expulsion from club



# 2022 MOA RULES

## Firearm Ranges

1. Membership pin must be displayed while at the range.
2. Members must sign in (SIGN IN FORMS IN BOX)
3. An individual may not use a range if is reserved by a group.
4. Any shooter under 18 Must be accompanied by an adult.
5. The MOA is not responsible for accidents.
6. Shooting has inherent risks, potential for injury or death. You are choosing to shoot strictly at your own risk and acknowledge all risks therein.
7. Eye and hearing protection are required while on the range.
8. Shooting Times
  - a. 9 AM - 3PM
9. You are only permitted to shoot in designated areas
10. No ammo is permitted in gun safe zone
11. Keep range clean, pick up all trash, debris and spent casings before you leave
12. Communicate with other members on the range for safe commands.
13. When persons are down range all firearms must be unloaded, cleared and holstered, actions open, ammunition and magazines not near the firearm.
14. Never go beyond the firing line when people are shooting
  - a. Ex: Do not walk down range, do not bend over to pick something up if it falls and bounces ahead of the firing line always, wait until everyone is done shooting.
15. No firearms are to be touched when persons are down range.
16. Do not shoot directly at barricades, anchor posts, target stands, support wires or wildlife.
17. Muzzles must never rise above the berm.
18. Absolutely NO Drugs or Alcohol
19. Shoot only authorized targets
20. Do not shoot glass, plastic, wood, steel or other reactive targets including but not limited to explosive targets, without written permission from the board of directors.
21. Destruction of property means expulsion from the association.
22. Only service dogs permitted at the gun ranges, no pets allowed.
23. Unattended guns should not be accessible to unauthorized persons
24. Use the correct ammunition for your firearm
25. You are responsible for every round fired from your firearm
26. Anyone can call cease fire. When cease fire is called, all shooters must stop firing immediately.
27. This range is limited to common small caliber ammunition only.

28. No incendiary, tracer, armor piercing, steel core ammunition, black powder or explosives.
29. No open toed or open foot shoe wear (flip flops, crocs, high heels, flat, etc.)
30. No sleeveless, low cut or crop top shirts.
31. No cleaning of firearms on the range or parking lot violations.
32. All violations will be subject to disciplinary actions at the discretion of the MOA
33. Any criminal actions will be subject to state and federal laws members: this property is here for you so we please protect it!
34. If you feel someone is doing something wrong, contact Kerry Dugan or Jason White.
35. Things that you can do:
  - a. Take picture of the person and vehicle on your cell phone
  - b. Obtain the person(s) membership number
  - c. Get the description of the vehicle and the license plate number.
  - d. If you see someone pin or receipt, please contact the Range Committee.
  - e. If you see someone breaking the law, please call 911.

# 2022 MOA RULES

## Indoor and Outdoor Archery Ranges

1. Membership pin must be displayed while at the range.
2. The MOA, at its discretion, may take any and all necessary action to assure the safe operation and use of its facilities.
3. Permitted Equipment: Longbow, Recurve or Compound bow. Full size Crossbow with minimum draw weight of 75 pounds. (Air bows are not permitted). The MOA reserves the right and has final decision on what may be permitted on the range.
4. Only Target /Field Points are allowed. No fixed/mechanical or hunting style broadheads allowed!
5. Personal equipment must be inspected by the individual and maintained for safe operation.
6. No more than six (6) arrows/bolts will be shot at each target per round.
7. All shooting will be from the marked firing line only.
8. Only straight in-lane shooting is permitted. No crossing shots, roving or clout.
9. When a "Cease Fire" is called, all arrows/bolts are to be removed from the bows and all bows are to be placed safely on a bow rack. Crossbows must have arrow/bolt removed and the safety engaged.
10. Once all bows are secured on a bow rack (crossbows not cocked and unloaded) and the firing line is declared "Clear", archers may enter the range to retrieve their arrows/bolts downrange.
11. When the firing line is declared "Hot", archers may retrieve their bows from the bow rack, approach the firing line, nock arrows/bolts and resume.
12. The MOA reserves the right to revoke usage rights to any individual who does not comply with the Archery Range Rules.
13. Avoid shooting arrows into other arrows already in targets.
14. Shot rotation to preserve targets is greatly appreciated.
15. Service dogs only permitted at archery range; no pets allowed
16. Destruction of property means Membership expulsion.

# 2022 MOA RULES

## Camping

1. Campsites are \$20 per night. Pay camping fee at the pay station located at campground or you can prepay through our website.
2. Campsites must display permit receipt
3. Campsite rentals must be done by an MOA MEMBER
4. NO Littering! All trash is to be placed in trash receptacles or taken with you
5. NO glass bottles or foam containers
6. Fires in designated areas only
7. Only two vehicles permitted per camp site
8. Maximum of 6 people permitted per campsite
9. Pets must be on a leash at all times
  - You are responsible to pick up and dispose of your pets' waste
10. Quiet hours are from 10pm to 7am
11. Campfires must be attended at all times
  - No burning of leaves
12. Camping checkout time is 2pm
13. Destruction of property means expulsion from the organization
14. No dumping of sewage or waste water

1. All violations will be subject to disciplinary actions at the discretion of the MOA.
2. Any criminal actions will be subject to State and Federal laws.

1. Take pictures with your cell phone
2. Get their Membership Number
3. Get their vehicle description and license plate number
4. If you feel someone is keeping too many fish, keep track of the day and the amount of fish, along with their pin # and contact the Fish Committee or drop a note in the drop box with the information.
